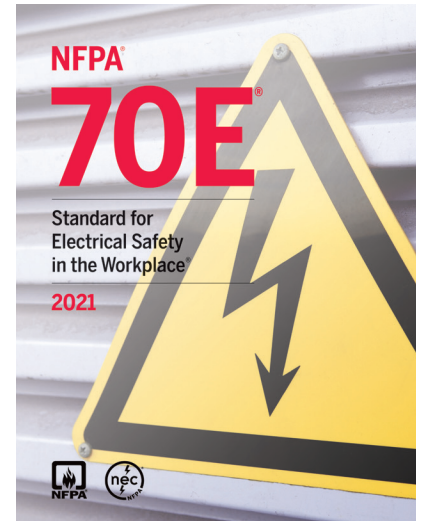
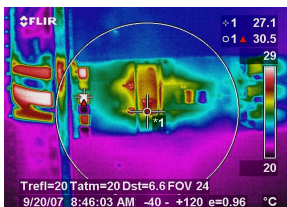

- Temperature can reach 35,000 degrees Fahrenheit
- Employer is responsible for employee safety
- Failure to follow guidelines may result in injury or death

The program is based on NFPA 70E, Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace, 2021 Edition, which sets requirements for safe work practices to protect personnel by reducing exposure to electrical hazards.
